



The Scottish Christian Party's Manifesto, *Another Approach*, covers every area of the Scottish Parliament's responsibilities.

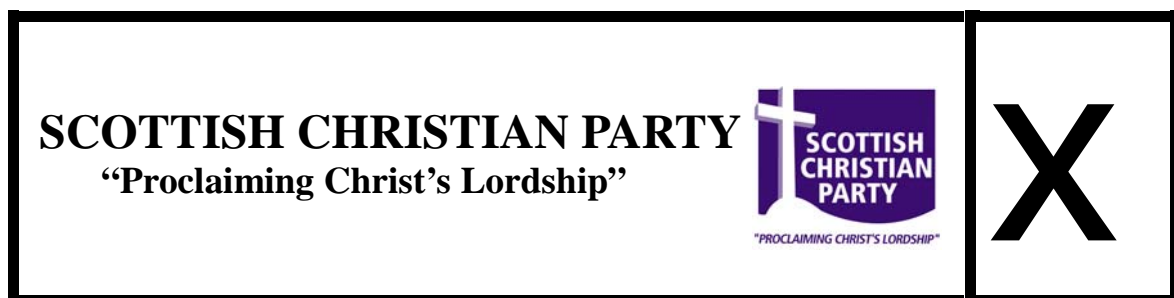
Our Action Priorities include:

- **Education** – real parental control over content and nature of their children's education; Educational Voucher Scheme to allow parental choice; use of reasonable force to maintain discipline in school; teaching children well-proven values such as chastity before marriage, faithfulness in marriage, and honesty and respect in all relationships
- **Health** – support the NHS; grant legal personality to the unborn child; ban abortion; publicise the catastrophic effects of ungodly behaviour such as excessive drinking, drug addiction, and sexual promiscuity and perversion
- **Housing** – provide affordable local family housing; greater involvement of tenants in running housing schemes
- **Law and Home Affairs** – abolish the discriminating Sexual Orientation Regulations; zero tolerance on illegal drug possession; full restitution for victims of crime; referendum on the restoration of capital punishment
- **Environment** – achieve self-sufficiency in energy; develop joined-up transport; reduce congestion; care for the environment
- **Economic Development** – stimulate local businesses; reduce red-tape; increase training and apprenticeship schemes; invest in further and higher education
- **Other Action Highlights** – oppose super casinos; extend our national fishing waters to the international law limit of 200 miles; abolish prescription charges; extend the Additional Member System of voting to local authority elections; give the tax advantages of civil partnerships to all committed to living together as a single household eg. two sisters house sharing in their old age; referendum on the re-instatement of Section 28 (Section 2A) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act of 1986

The System of Proportional Representation used in the Scottish Parliamentary Elections is designed to help smaller Parties like the **Scottish Christian Party** to win seats.
